



## International Student Data Form

This form is required of all international students applying for admission to Eastern Nazarene College in order to evaluate whether immigration sponsorship in F-1 student status is required. Please answer all questions and return this form to the International Student Advisor in the ENC Office of Admissions, along with (1) copies of current passport and complete immigration documents, (2) original Sponsorship Certification Form, and (3) original bank statements showing sufficient financial resources. Students wishing to transfer F-1 sponsorship from another U.S. school must also submit (4) an F-1 Transfer-In Form. Once all required forms are received and evaluated to be complete, an I-20 immigration document will be issued (if applicable) along with instructions about how to apply for a visa at a U.S. embassy or consulate, and/or about how to enter the U.S. in F-1 status. This form (sections 1-3) is also required from international students in other nonimmigrant statuses in the U.S.

If your spouse or children (under the age of 21) wish to accompany you to the U.S. or following later to join you during your studies at Eastern Nazarene College, they will need a separate Form I-20 in order to apply for an F-2 dependent visa. Please note that you may need to show additional financial support to cover their living expenses in the U.S. (If more space is needed, please attach separate sheet.)
