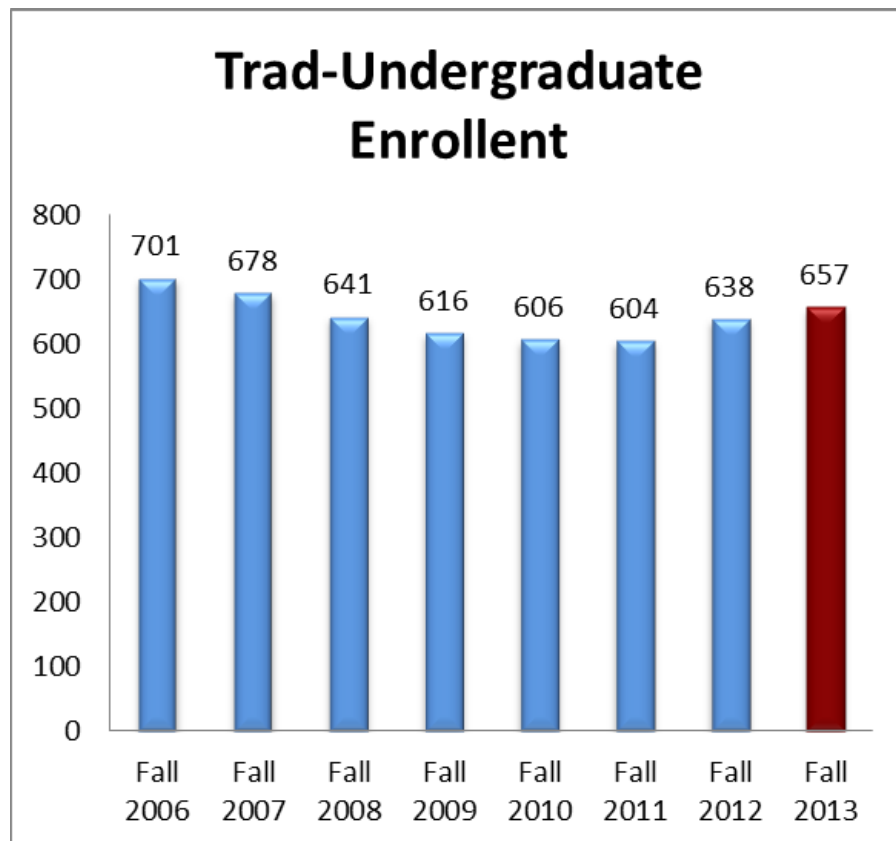
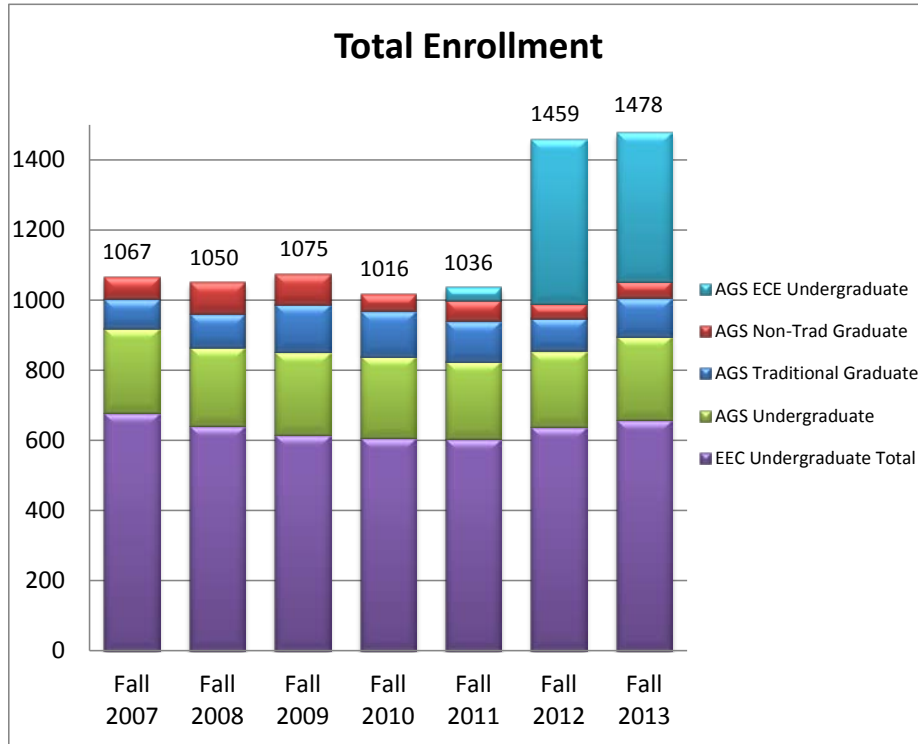

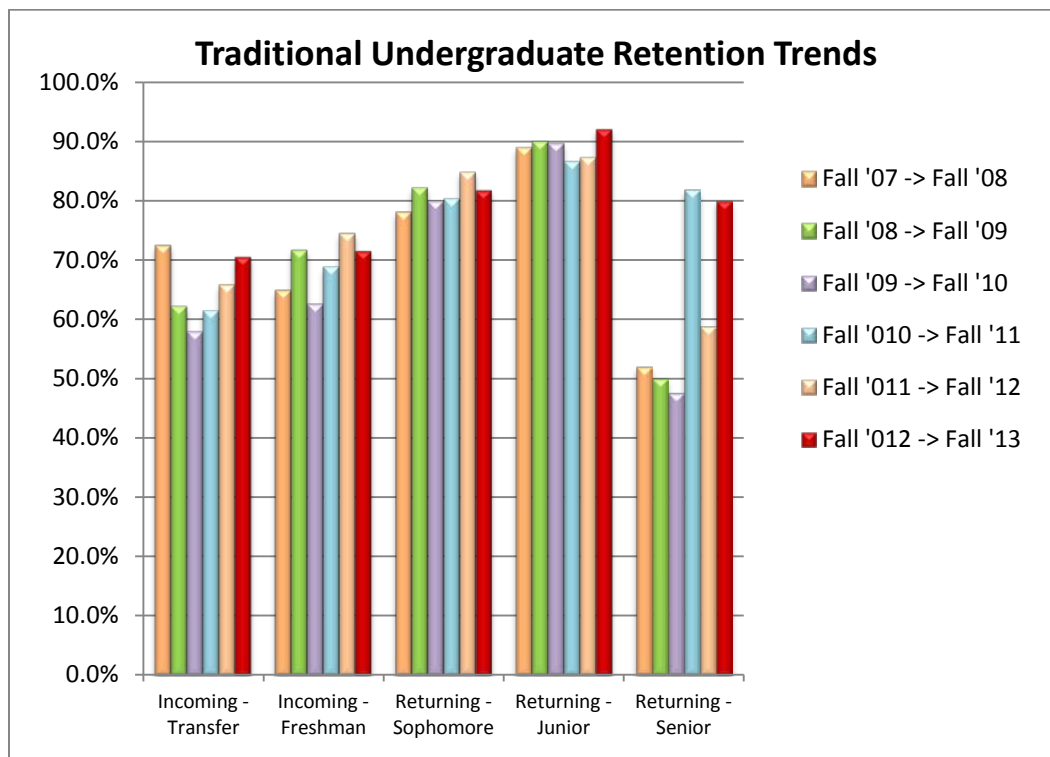

Overall Eastern Nazarene College celebrates an enrollment growth of +19 students (+1.3%) from 1059 in Fall 2012 to 1478 for Fall 2013. This growth is a result of strong retention in the traditional undergraduate programs along with increased enrollment yield and decreased deposit melt for incoming students in addition to the impressive retention in the AGS early childhood education program and growth in both the AGS graduate and undergraduate programs.

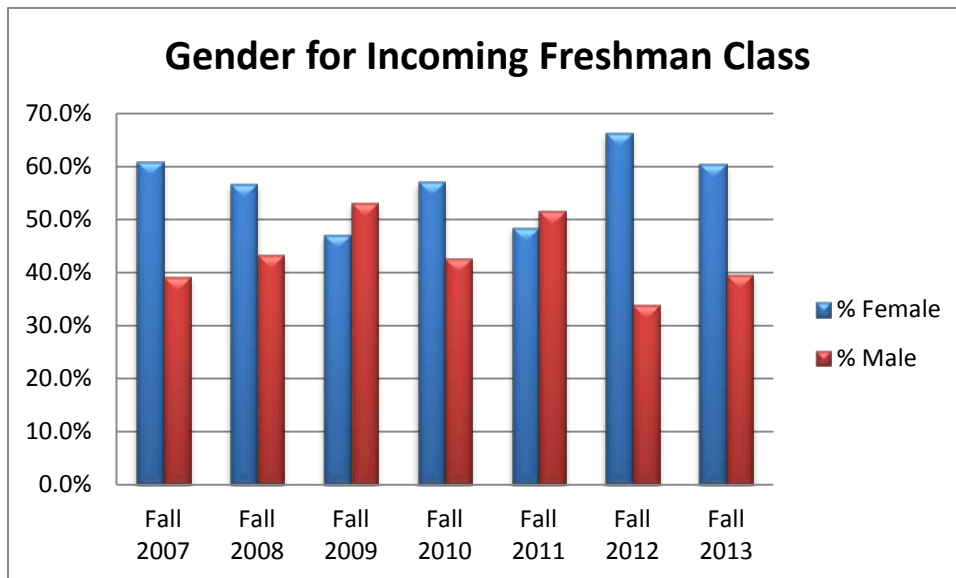
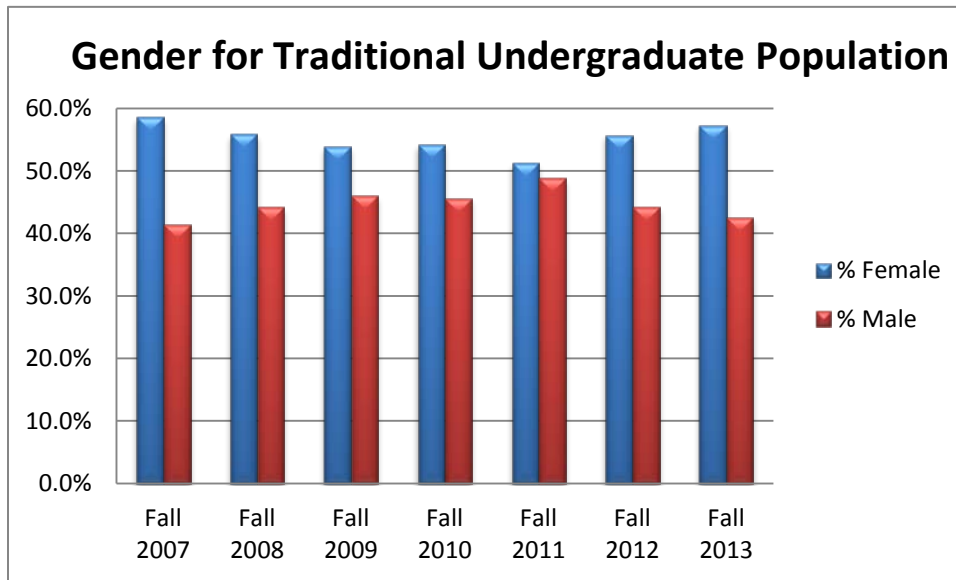

The freshman retention for students returning from fall 2009 fell to 62.7% leading into Fall of 2010. Since then, through strong retention efforts the freshmen retention has increase to a high of 74.5% for fall 2012 and 71.6% for fall 2013. The retention committee continues to respond to reports of concern from ENC faculty and staff, as well as making strategic use of endowed grants, to assist students who may choose to leave due to financial concerns. The overall college retention rate has risen steadily from a low of 71.4% for fall 2009 to 76.9% for fall 2013.

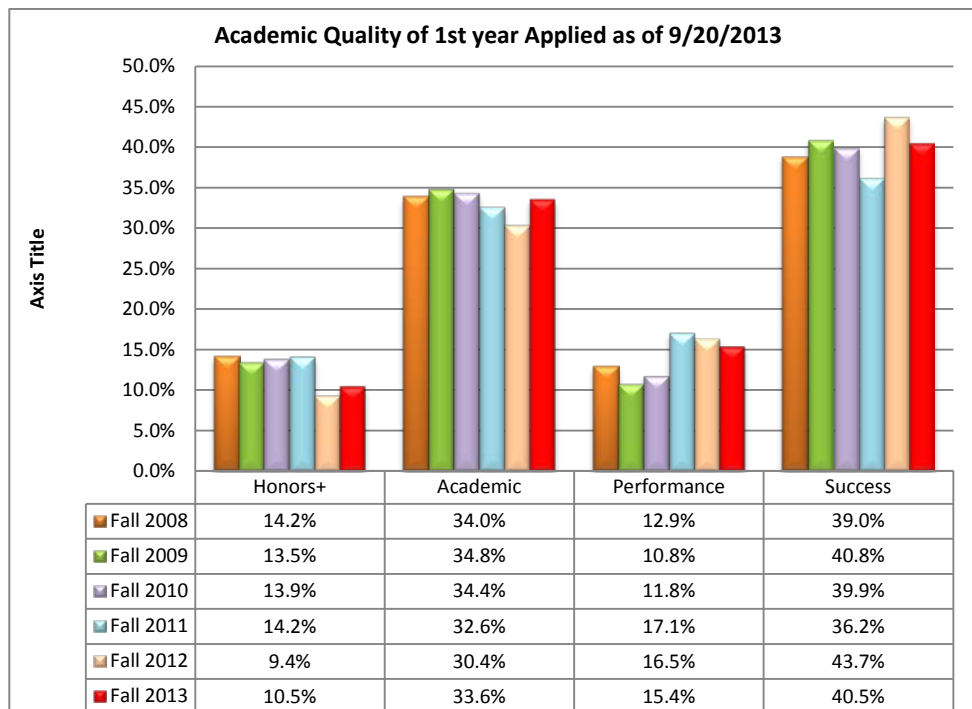
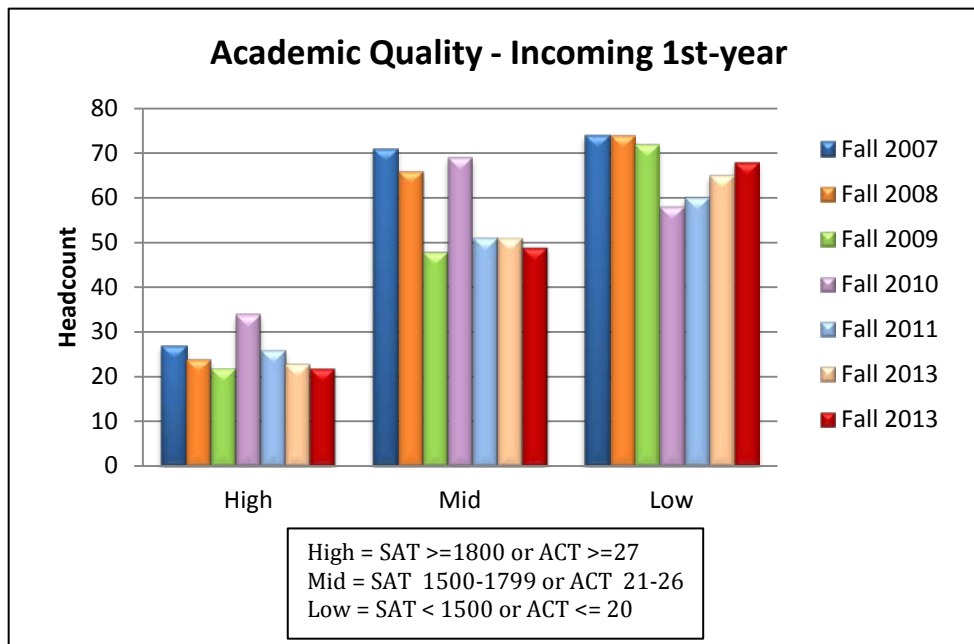

Off-zone students are those that come to ENC from outside of the ENC educational region, which stretches from Virginia up through Pennsylvania and New York and into New England and Maine.

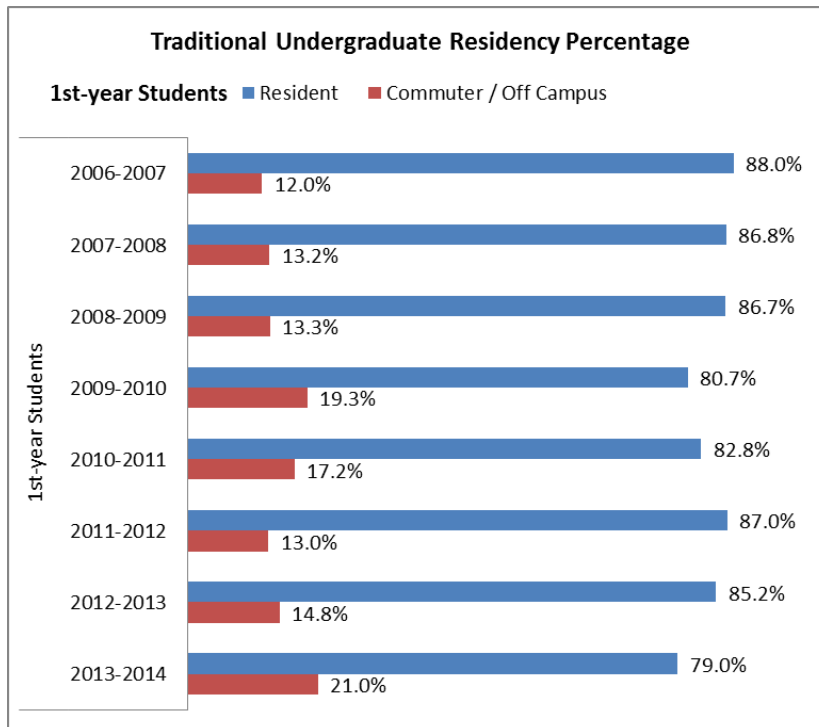
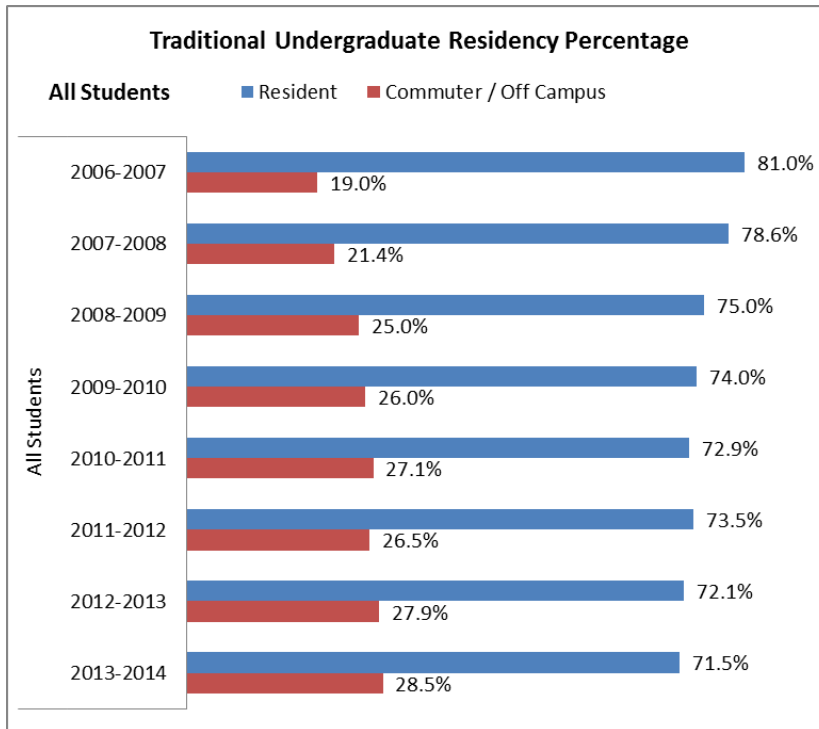

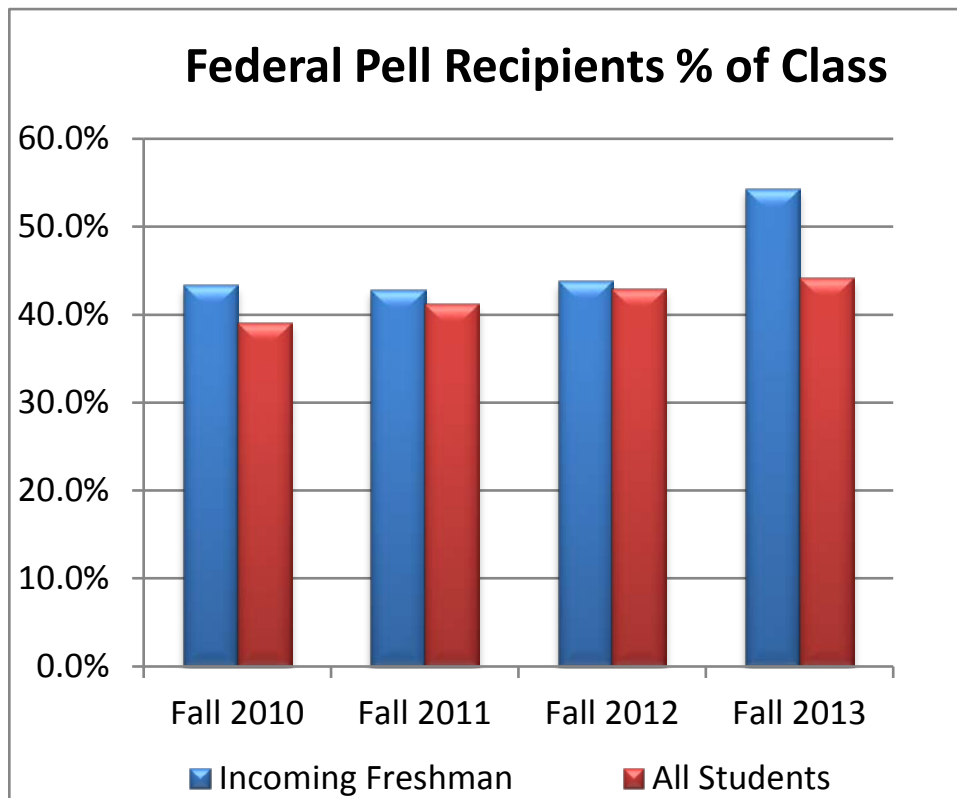

Federal Pell Recipients & Student Debt Load

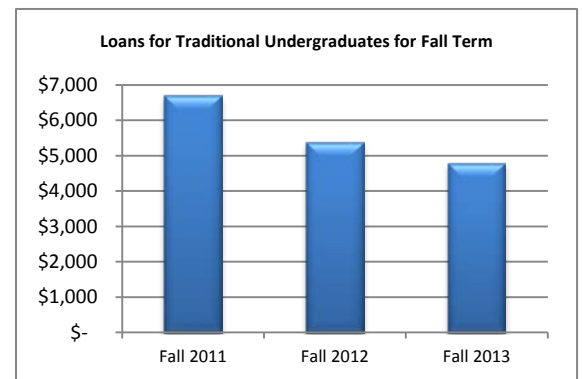
