

## ENCY Nominee's for... "Mr. Crusader"

**Definition:** The male athlete representing *the heart and soul of ENC athletics, both on and off the field, preference given to a senior.*

**Nominee:** Luc Jasmin

**Sport:** Men's Basketball **Class:** Junior

**Applicable Info:** Luc was a CCC Honorable Mention averaging 13.4 ppg (11th in the CCC) and 6.3 rpg (12 in the CCC). He shot 57% from the field (2nd in the CCC), despite constant double and triple teaming on him by opponents this year. Luc served as a co-captain for the second straight year. He is an RA and serves as an outstanding example of a Christian role model on campus.

**Sport:** Baseball **Class:** Senior

**Applicable Info:** AJ has been one of the most successful athletes in ENC sports history. His honors include CCC Rookie of the year, First Team all-conference, and is one of only the three players to be named All- New England Region. This year he broke the career record for hits, previously 150, with 170 and counting and was the first player ever with 100 stolen bases. He has led the baseball team to 83 victories in 4 seasons while serving as team captain and devotional leader as well as serving as a resident assistant in the men's dormitory. In May, he will complete a second bachelors degree (Business and Mathematics) and accomplished a 3.5 grade point average this fall. He is also a regular attender at Wollaston Church of the Nazarene and supports many of the other ENC sports as a fan.

**Sport:** Men's Soccer **Class:** Junior
